

2 TO 3 YEARS

Your child is now beginning to test the boundaries, their memory is developing fast and imagination is soaring.

Developmental milestones you may observe:



EMOTIONAL

- May demand adult attention
- Begins to show guilt or remorse for misdeeds
- Shows strong attachment to parent or carer

COGNITIVE

- Recognises familiar objects and pictures
- Begins to count with numbers
- Recognises similarities and differences



LANGUAGE

- Asks lots of questions
- Copies words and actions
- Makes music, sings and dances

PHYSICAL

- Walks, jumps and climbs easily
- Avoids obstacles and stops readily
- Self-feeds using utensils and a cup



SOCIAL

- Plays with other children
- Unlikely to share toy without protest
- Takes part in make-believe play
